Paper and your website:

In addition to the typed, written response, please make sure to add relevant information (i.e. indicator, artifact description, and rationale) for Standard 6 on your TaskStream website.

Indicator is K: “use of a variety of media communication tools, including audiovisual aids and computers, including education technology, to enrich learning opportunities.”

Artifact description: Two parts: (1) A brief description of your Smartboard Activity and its goal (i.e. the first question from the paper); (2) A brief description of your WebQuest Activity and its goal

Rationale: Two Parts: (1) A brief explanation of how your Smartboard activity enriched learning opportunities (i.e. second question from the paper); (2) A brief description of how your WebQuest enriches learning opportunities
